- Meeting began at 6:21 P.M.
- Attending: 14 brother Knights
- Grand Knight Bob Michaud led all brother Knights in praying The Our Father, The Hail Mary, and The Glory Be, and in reciting The Pledge of Allegiance.
- Last meetings minutes were posted online. A motion was made by Deputy Grand Knight Jim Daigle, and seconded by brother Andy Maier, to accept minutes as posted; this was agreed to by all present.
- Grand Knight's Report: Fr. Dan attended today's Grand Knights Meeting - keep him in your prayers; the monthly Rosary for May will be at The Basilica on Wednesday, May 6<sup>th</sup>; there will be a Fraternal Benefits on May 11, Monday, at 6 P.M. at Holy Family Church Hall, presented by a KofC Insurance Agent & an attorney, it will be live-streamed and recorded, with light refreshments; a 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Program will be held on Wednesday, April 29<sup>th</sup> at The Basilica; on Sunday, May 17<sup>th</sup>, after 8:30 A.M. Holy Mass, there will be an awards presentation for the 2 girls who placed first in their age categories at the International level for the Soccer Challenge held last year - one is Arcadia Castonguay, daughter of brother Justin Castonguay; going forward, tickets for The Annual St. Patrick's Dinner will be sold after all masses; a scholarship application was passed around (Victoria B.)
- Financial Secretary's Report: No communications; 3 bills - \$101.24 - St. Patrick's Dinner tablecloths, \$117.90 - 26 St. Cards (donation to homeless family), \$737.00 - G.K. Devin St. Jean (Canned beer for St. Patrick's Dinner) - funds from the District account: a motion was made to pay these bills by V.G.K. Jim D., seconded by Warden Don C., & agreed to by all present.
- Treasurer's Report: As of March 31, 2026 - Scholarship Account: \$1,627.79, Checking Account: \$2,636.25; all checks have cleared.

• Old Business: Sheds (to store our equipment) Discussion - place it in first non-handicap space, buy Knights items. maybe put in a crèche, need to fit our fire pit panels (10 feet long, different options [Hammond Lumber - \$3,415 for an all wood/asphalt roof, currently in stock / Don's Mini-Barns - \$3,200 for an all wood/asphalt roof, currently in stock / Another - \$4,500 (place in Auburn)] Agreed to vote on options next month.

Dan B. will bring tools this coming Saturday, April 11<sup>th</sup> at 10 a.m. to put up council awards on the walls of our room; GK Bob M. to research Credit Card readers to be used at "out-of-the-ordinary" parish events, or might use Venmo or QR codes; proposal to rejuvenate the Lisbon 4<sup>th</sup> Degree Assembly, due to an influx of new 4<sup>th</sup> Degree members - GK Bob M. will "ruminate" on it.
