Grand Knight's Corner

Dear Brother Knights,

It has been a really busy summer, but as the weather begins to cool, it's time to return to our regular schedule. In particular, our first Baked Bean & Casserole Supper is coming up on **Saturday**, **October 4 at 5:00 PM** (immediately following the 4:00 PM Mass) at **Holy Trinity Hall**.

Brother Knights—this is an important event: it's our first "regular season" bean supper, and it coincides with the annual **Rosary Rally** that same morning in Lisbon. The rally will begin at **10:00 AM**, leaving from the **Worumbo Mill** parking lot, praying the Rosary throughout the City of Lisbon, and ending back at the parking lot. Speaking of Brother Bob, he is hosting the **Southern Maine Men's Retreat** at **Camp Metchuana** this coming weekend—**September 26–28**. I realize this is a last-minute reminder, but I believe you can still join if you like.

Father Gabriel Odin and Michael Fournier—have signed up as e-members and are ready to attend the next Degree Exemplification on Sunday, September 28, immediately following the 10:30 AM Mass at the Basilica.
